### Agreement

1. The design will be based on a traditional quilt, a family heirloom, or a pieced paper quilt pattern.
2. I will contact Deanna Buell at [deannabuell1@gmail.com](mailto:deannabuell1@gmail.com) to determine if the chosen quilt square already been selected for display by another party. There should be no duplicate patterns displayed on the Route 66 Pacific, Missouri Quilt Square Trail
3. I understand the quilt square is a public art installation and should not be used as a form of advertising. No logos, words or initials will be used in the design of the quilt square. Designs are acceptable.
4. The quilt square will be 3'x3' or larger, hung on pointe or square on a building. Please contact Deanna Buell at [deannabuell1@gmail.com](mailto:deannabuell1@gmail.com) if you need assistance determining an appropriate size for your building. If a building is not a practical location, the quilt square may be mounted to a pair of posts in the ground.
5. A Route 66 shield sign will be attached to a bottom corner of the quilt square (if hung square), or on a bottom edge (if hung on pointe). I will receive the Route 66 shield at the class. It is my responsibility to attach the sign to the quilt square. If not attending the class, I will purchase the shield, and bring a shield to Red Cedar Inn to ensure it would be acceptable to use on this trail.
6. I will keep the area near the quilt square neat, clean, and free of debris and vegetation that would block direct view of the quilt square.
7. The quilt square will be visible from areas of public access, such as sidewalks and streets/roads.
8. I understand that travelers will take photos of the quilt square.
9. I understand photographs of the quilt square and the building and property on which it is located may be used to promote the quilt trail.
10. It is my responsibility to post notices limiting or restricting public access to the property, such as: *Private—Enjoy from the road. Visit as Posted. Please visit during the hours of XX-XX, etc.*
11. I will notify Kelly O'Malley at [komalley@pacificmissouri.com](mailto:komalley@pacificmissouri.com) if the quilt square becomes damaged due to a weather or catastrophic event (tornado, hail storm, fire, etc.) and therefore must be removed from the trail.
12. I agree to keep the quilt square on public display for a minimum of 3 years. It is my responsibility to maintain the condition of the quilt square. In the event my property is sold, or the business location closes, I will notify Kelly O'Malley at [komalley@pacificmissouri.com](mailto:komalley@pacificmissouri.com)
13. I understand that I own the quilt square and therefore will not hold the City of Pacific liable for any damage to the building or property related to the placement or removal of the quilt square.
14. I understand that the location of my quilt square will be made available to the public via such maps, social media, websites, etc.
15. I will notify Kelly O'Malley at [komalley@pacificmissouri.com](mailto:komalley@pacificmissouri.com) when the quilt square is placed on my building or property and ready to be made public on maps, social media, website, etc.
