


Q1 Are you a resident of the City of Pacific?



Q2 How often do you or your family use the Pacific Community Pool?



Q3 If the Community Pool was renovated to add new features, or if the City were to build an entirely new Pool facility, how much more would do you think you or your family would use the pool?



Q4 The Community Pool is one of many park facilities maintained by the City of Pacific. How important is the Community Pool to the Parks system?



Q5 The City of Pacific is considering repair / renovations to the existing Community Pool, or possibly constructing a new pool facility. Which of the following would you prefer?






